#### PRAYING ACROSS THE MILES



# UPCOMING DIVINE LOVE RETREAT, SEPTEMBER 2018 - PHOENIX, ARIZONA

This resort is nestled at the base of South Mountain Preserve, one of the country's largest municipal parks. # NOT FEELING THE BURNING OF THE LOVE? (MICHAEL NEDBAL)

From time to time, truth seekers share their frustration in praying for God's Love and not feeling any physical sensations, burning or otherwise. Some ultimately conclude that those who describe a burning sensation in their souls are deluding themselves, that their minds are manifesting those physical sensations, and that there is no such thing as Divine Love.

The most direct evidence we have for a burning/glowing sensation as a result of the inflowing of God's Love is a testimony by Dr. Stone and channeled messages through Dr. Samuels. In his testimony Dr. Stone stated: "we [Dr. Stone and James Padgett] began to pray for the Divine Love, letting our soul longings go out to the Heavenly Father; and, in time, a feeling came glowing into the region of our

hearts." Dr. Samuels received a channeled message from Jesus (Revelation 5) who described his experience with the Hebrew rulers of his time: "if they wished to assert the truth of my words, they should try and test my teachings that the Father's Love was now available, and pray for it to the Father in earnest prayer, and see whether, if this was done in sincerity, the Father's Love, conveyed through the Holy Spirit, would burn and glow in the soul, by which sign they would realize His Love was present therein." In Revelation 7, Jesus further stated, "Love came burning more and more brightly in my soul, and I felt the glow and the incoming of the Love in my soul". Jesus also said in Revelation 44 that, "the burning in my soul constantly told me that I could die only in the flesh and that I would retain my consciousness after my passing over." It seems that, similarly to Dr. Stone, Dr. Samuels believed that the burning sensation in the heart region represented the inflowing of God's Divine Love. In The True Mission of Jesus (TGRABJ, Vol. I, p. XVII), he writes: "When one obtains the greatest attribute of God, the Divine Love, which manifests itself as a warm glow burning in the soul, as occurred to the refugees at Emmaus (Luke 24:32), then he is actually feeling or perceiving the Great Soul of God to the degree he partakes of that Love."

References to a burning sensation when receiving God's Love are not very prevalent in the messages channeled through James Padgett. Ann Rollins (TGRABJ, Vol. II, p. 9) stated that evidence of possession of the Love relates to the beauty of the soul as seen through spiritual eyes: "The Love of God cannot be defined, for It passes all understanding. But the result of that Love, when in the souls of men, can be seen and felt in the exceeding beauty of the countenances of men and their wonderful happiness." Celestial spirit St. Andrew stated (TGRABJ, Vol I, p. 188): "The love that casts out all fear is the Divine Love of the Father, and when a spirit obtains that, there exists no such thing as fear." Ann Rollins also relates that possession of the Divine Love will bring greater happiness (TGRABJ, Vol II, p. 279): "each successive stage of that progress has brought us greater and greater happiness".

The channeled messages through James Padgett seem to speak more of the results of the inflowing of God's Love rather than physical manifestations of the Love. Yet, based on Dr. Stone's testimony, James Padgett did acknowledge feeling a glowing in his heart.

Eva Peck pointed out that, similar to the messages through James Padgett, the Bible also teaches about the results of the Love. In Galatians 5:22-24 we read: "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. Those who belong to Christ Jesus [follow his teachings] have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires." This then makes us a new creature/creation as we are told in 2 Corinthians 5:17: "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ [Divine Love], he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!"

What then are we to make of this seemingly conflicting information? Is the burning sensation a real, tangible proof of the inflowing of God's Love? Is it possible that people are mentally manifesting a feeling of warmth in their chest based on a strong mental need to feel God's Love? From a scientific standpoint, we cannot rule out that possibility, but it certainly

would be difficult to test that hypothesis. What about the people in the community who have been praying for the Love a long time but have never felt the burning sensation? Are they just not praying hard enough?

Could it be that the burning sensation refers to the "burning off" of soul encrustations? Perhaps the feeling of burning is actually the Divine Love working on sin in our souls. A channeled message from Ben Robinson (TGRABJ, Vol. IV, p. 378) alludes to this possibility: "I have my recollections of what I did on earth and they seem to burn me and cause my sufferings." If this is true, then the manifestation of burning, or even pain, may be directly related to the state of one's soul and the degree of Divine Love loosening false beliefs and burning away past encrustations.

I am aware of individuals in the community that never felt the burning sensation and they believe that they possess God's Love within their souls. This lack of a burning feeling on their part may have to do with their involvement in church/spiritual activities for a large portion of their life. Perhaps they had purified their natural love to such an extent that the Divine Love had nothing to burn away which would have resulted in a physical sensation.

I think we can all agree that a physical response or manifestation as a result of prayer to our Heavenly Father is something we all desire. We want to know that our prayers are being heard and answered. Caution is needed, however, in making this burning sensation an absolute indicator of the presence of the Divine Love in one's soul. Having a specific expectation of the Father's response is, in essence, trying to control our relationship with God.

We each have a unique personal relationship with our Heavenly Father. Who is to say that one person's experience can't be completely different from another's experience? When we try to control a situation or a response from God, we are not surrendering and are only allowing ourselves to perceive a tiny window of opportunities that may be presented to us. Perhaps a better way to approach our Heavenly Father is to completely surrender to Him in Love and make it ok not to feel anything. Tell God – and sincerely mean it – that you love Him with all your heart and soul, and that whatever happens in return is completely fine with you. Let Him know that you desire to serve Him in whatever capacity He wishes.

If you are not physically feeling God's Love, make that ok. Know that God is hearing your prayers and that He loves you. Open up your heart and let go of your mind's expectations of what your relationship with Him should be like. He may have something unique in store for you. Embrace the Love that you and your Father share and continue asking for more of His Divine Love. He will answer you, but it may not be in the way you expect.


Completely surrendering to God takes a leap of faith. It can be scary to allow an omnipotent God do whatever He/She wishes to do in your life. That leap of faith, however, isn't so difficult when you believe that God is Love and that He loves us more than we can imagine. If you truly want to know God and have a personal relationship with Him, tell Him that. And then continue praying and conversing with Him, even if you think you are just talking to yourself. Keep having that soulful desire to be with Him and truths will be revealed to your soul. You will grow in your relationship with God in ways not governed by anything written in a book, but unique and special to you.

# PADGETT FAMILY HEADSTONES RESTORATION REVISITED (JUDY GEBHARDT)

In May, Patricia Doyle, Holly Bianco, Joan Warden and I embarked on a graveside tour to the Washington DC area to visit the Padgett family tombstones that began a process of restoration last November. The restoration became possible as a result of money raised by Divine Love Community members for a life-time endowment (see Divine Love Newsletters, September 2017, p. 7, and November 2017, p. 9).

The Mount Olivet Cemetery in Frederick, Maryland, where Helen Padgett and other members of her family are buried, is really nice. It is located on flat land, not a hillside like some of the





other cemeteries we visited during our trip. It has a lovely little chapel which unfortunately we were not able to enter. We did, however, see inside the Mausoleum Chapel that has the most beautiful stained-glass angel.

We were happy to meet up with Bill Frase at the Cemetery. He was very helpful in using his Boy Scout knife to put holes in the water jug container that we used for our flowers.

Ron Pearsey, the Cemetery Superintendent, graciously took us to the Padgett graveside. He explained that the restoration product that was applied last November is still working and that the headstones will become yet whiter than they are now. Because we arranged for this endowment, a plaque stands in front of the main headstone showing that it is endowed. This means that it will

be perpetually taken care of as long as the Cemetery exists, and will always sparkle and shine the way that Helen does in our hearts.

Ron has been the Superintendent of Mount Olivet Cemetery now for fifty years. I asked him if he has a plot there and he answered in the affirmative and pointed in the direction where it is located. He said he plans to be buried where he works.

Ron introduced us to a young man, Chris, who is in charge of the Cemetery blog. Chris created a series called "Stories in Stone" and posts a new story on the blog each week. I would like to invite anyone who feels so inclined to write an article about Helen and submit it to Chris. It would be a wonderful vehicle to get the message out as to exactly who was Helen Padgett.

I am so glad we initiated this restoration of the Padgett family headstones. I felt sick to see Helen's name so dark that you could hardly see it. Now her name and her family's names really glow as we all know that they themselves do in the spirit world. (Incidentally, Helenita just celebrated her 100-year anniversary of passing over.) Big thanks to all who took part in this little campaign. I feel certain that Helen and her family are very happy that we have done this in their memory.



Below are some up-to-date photos of Helen's headstone, with a pre-treatment photo for comparison. It is amazing to see the difference in the headstones in just six short months – since November. It will be interesting to see the results in a year. We put flowers in the large vase, but by now, soil would have been placed inside it with annuals planted, so there will be flowers in the vase all summer. I believe this is another endowment that was set up for the plot. Notice how Helen's headstone now really shines among all the others.

We also visited New Market and saw the little church that Joseph Salyards went to as well as his headstone. From my research, I learned that Joseph was somewhat famous in his time. He did a lot of poetry writing and also worked with the then pastor of the church on translating the German Bible into English. It took them seven years. The Hinkel family is also well known in this little town. They owned the newspaper while they lived there. It is likely that James Padgett attended the same church while he was living and going to school in New Market.

Thanks to these two hard-working ladies, DLSF is proud to announce that *Messages of Love – 1958 - 1970 –* representing Alec's legacy, are now available to the world! This treasure trove contains hundreds of messages from Jesus, his disciples and other Celestial Angels that were channeled through several mediums. Alec initiated 24 Divine Love Prayer Circles in the Vancouver area, and during the last two years of his life, came very close to the development of physical manifestation or "Direct Voice" of Celestial spirits. 
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# **UPS AND DOWNS IN LIFE**

PADGETT MESSAGE
TGRABJ, Vol. 1, P. 57

Matthew: The Salvation that Jesus taught.

Let me write a few lines tonight as I desire to tell you of a truth that to me seems important for mankind to know in order that they may comprehend the truth of their personal salvation.

I am a spirit of soul development and an inhabitant of the Celestial Heavens, where only those whose souls have been transformed by the Divine Love into the very nature and Essence of the Father can find a habitation. I will not write at any great length and have only one idea or truth to convey, and that is "that no man or spirit can possibly receive the full salvation that Jesus taught and exemplified in his own person, who does not become wholly possessed in his soul of this Divine Love of the Father, and becomes rid of the conditions and attributes that belong to his created soul." This soul was



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not created with any of the divine attributes or qualities, but simply and merely with those which you may call human and which all men and spirits who have not experienced the transformation possess.

The God-man, as Jesus is sometimes designated by your religious writers and theologians, was not at the time of his creation or appearance in the flesh possessed of these Divine attributes, which are of the nature and Essence of the Father, but only of the human attributes which belonged to the perfect man - that is, the man who was the perfect creature as he existed before the fall of the first parents, when sin had not entered into their souls, and into the world of men's existence. Jesus was from the time of his birth, the perfect man, and, consequently, without sin - all his moral qualities being in complete harmony with the will of God and the laws controlling his creation; yet, he was not greater than were the first parents prior to their act of disobedience.

There was nothing of God, in the sense of the Divine that entered into his nature or constituents, and, if the Divine Love had not come into and transformed his soul, he would have remained only the perfect creature of a quality no higher or greater than was bestowed upon the first man; and Jesus was as regards his possibilities and privileges, like this first man prior to his fall or death of the potentiality of becoming Divine, but differed from him in this: that Jesus embraced and made his own these privileges and hence became Divine, while the first man refused to embrace them and lost them, and remained the mere man though not the perfect man as he was created.

And while Jesus by reason of his possession of the Divine Love became divine, yet he never became the God-man, and never can, for there does not exist and never can be a God-man. God is God, alone, and never has and never can become man; and Jesus is man only and never can become God.

But Jesus is preeminently the Divine man, and may rightly be called the best beloved son of the Father, for he possesses more of the Divine Love and, consequently, more of the Essence and Nature of the Father, than does any other spirit of the Celestial Heavens, and with this possession there comes to him greater power and glory and knowledge. He may be described and understood as possessing and manifesting the Wisdom of the Father; and we spirits of the Celestial Kingdom recognize and acknowledge that superior wisdom of Jesus and are compelled by the very greatness and force of the wisdom, itself, to honor and abide in his authority.

And this transcendent and greatest possessor of the Father's wisdom is the same when he comes to you and reveals the truths of God as he is when in the highest spheres of the Celestial Kingdom clothed in all the glory of his nearness to the Father. As the voice on the Mount said "Hear ye him," I repeat to you and to all who may have the privilege and opportunity of reading or hearing his messages, hear ye him! And when hearing, believe and seek.

Well, my brother, I deemed it proper to write this short message and hope it may help you in the work. I will come again. Good night.
